## IMPORTANT F.O.C.C. C.H.V.R.S. INFORMATION

In order for F.O.C.C. members to maintain their C.H.V.R.S. status within the club, they **must** conform to the following requirements:-

- (a) Pay their club membership fee(s) **by** 31<sup>st</sup> December of each financial year.
- (b) Produce a statutory declaration form, completed in full and in a legible manner, with any unused lines "zipped" off. **N.B.** New club members, who have a vehicle(s) on the C.H.V.R.S., are not required to produce a statutory declaration for the first year of club registration and multiple vehicles can be put on the one statutory declaration form.
- (c) Produce the vehicle(s) **current** registration certificate(s).
- (d) Produce the "Certificate of Exemption" form for any L.H.D. vehicles.
- (e) Have your logbook, for each vehicle, available for signing by an Authorised Officer.
- (f) Before a **new** replacement logbook can be issued, produce the **old** logbook for cancellation.
- (g) Ensure that an Authorised Officer conducts a vehicle inspection, at least once every three (3) years.
- (h) Any alterations required to a members current logbook, **must only** be addressed by an Authorised Officer.

Any member, who does not wish to conform to the above, will have their C.H.V.R.S. status removed from the club registry.

## HISTORIC VEHICLE CLASSIFICATION

When it comes to classification of age, the following list may help you identify the period to which a particular vehicle belongs.

VETERAN AND EDWARDIAN -  
Manufactured prior to 31<sup>st</sup> December, 1918.

VINTAGE -  
Manufactured between 1<sup>st</sup> January, 1919 and 31<sup>st</sup> December, 1930.

POST VINTAGE –  
Manufactured between 1<sup>st</sup> January, 1931 and 31<sup>st</sup> December, 1949.

CLASSIC –  
Manufactured from 1<sup>st</sup> January, 1950 and 31<sup>st</sup> December, 1964.

MODERN CLASSIC –  
Manufactured from 1<sup>st</sup> January, 1965 to 31<sup>st</sup> December, 1978.
