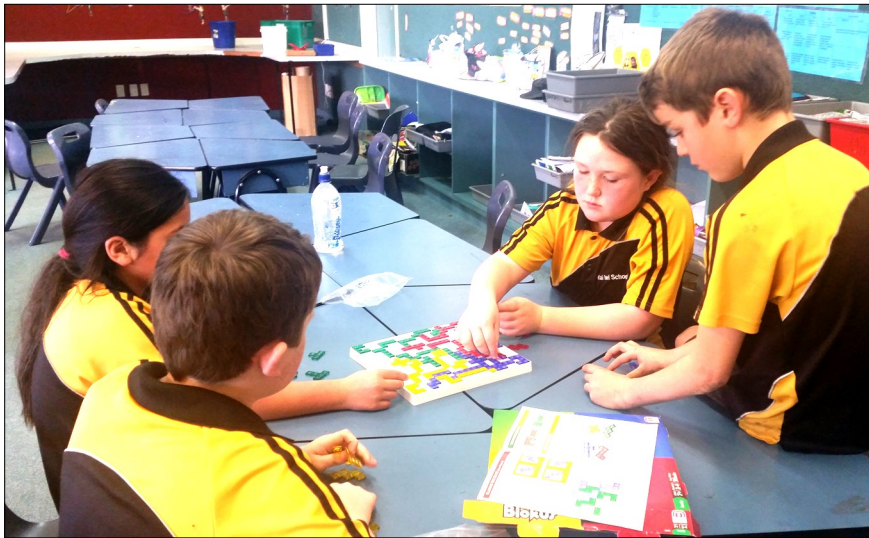
### HOCKEY PHOTOS LAST WEEK
