PRINCIPAL'S COMMENT

#### Kia ora koutou, Hi Everyone

Alert Level 1 - I am sure you were as pleased as I was to hear the Prime Minister's announcement about moving to Alert Level 1. For us, there will be no major changes to what we are doing and our school continues to be safe to attend, including any staff and children who are considered more vulnerable to COVID. We have a good cleaning routine in place, people who are sick are staying at home, and we continue to encourage good hygiene practices.
