

Hi Everyone Kia ora Koutou

Covid-19 - Well I think we need to call this week 'Cancellation Week'. Apart from all the sporting events that have been cancelled so far, we are also cancelling or postponing Parent Interviews, which were to take place next week, and Senior Camp. We will be putting them on hold until further notice. Assemblies will no longer take place, however, each class can hold their own mini assembly if they wish.

Reminder - schools remain open (Ministry of **Education)** - At this stage, we are not expecting widespread school closures. We are planning for temporary closures, like what is happening at Logan Park School, but as the World Health Organisation has confirmed, the risk to children remains low and parents should continue to send their kids to centres. schools and early learning Consequently any decisions about school closures will be made on a case by case basis. In the meantime, unless students are unwell themselves, then parents should keep sending them to schools and early learning centres as these environments continue to be safe and the best place for them to continue their learning.
