We have received our ERO report and I would like to thank the teachers, staff and board for all the hard work they have put in so that we could achieve such a positive report.


The Board of Trustees are already busy working together to setup our School Charter and the Strategic Plan, which are the documents that set the direction of the school for 2017 and beyond.
