PRINCIPAL'S COMMENT

Tena Koutou Katoa, Hi Everyone.

We only have just over a week until Term Two is over. The year is really flying by. This term the children have been studying Matariki, weather patterns and writing speeches.

Speeches - Today some of the children will be reading their speeches in front of the school. It can be really daunting and stressful for, not only children, but adults as well, to stand up in front of a crowd of people and read a speech. Even reading it to the class can be daunting.

The Years 5/6, 7/8 students will be judged today and the best ones may get to go to the West Cluster Speech Competition next week at Faith City School. The juniors are not judged but they can still participate in our school competition.

On Friday, the last day of term, some of the children will be able to read their speeches in assembly if they choose.

Uniforms - Some children are coming to school with no shoes. If your child comes to school without shoes we will be ringing parents to bring some for them. They are not allowed outside without them and if fine, children are not allowed to stay in their classrooms at break times unless for a very good reason (eg sickness, etc).

Also, next term we will be much stricter with the wearing of full school uniform. As for the shoes, if your child comes to school wearing something they shouldn't then parents will be rung.

Please note that school uniform orders need to be back tomorrow if uniform is needed for next term.

Lunches - Please remember, school lunches that need heating must be sent along in tin-foil or a small heat-proof dish to put in the pie warmer. Food wrapped in Glad Wrap or in plastic bowls, etc cannot be heated. Please ensure food has thawed before sending to school as the pie warmer isn't hot enough for thawing and heating through.
