CRICKET - TERM 4

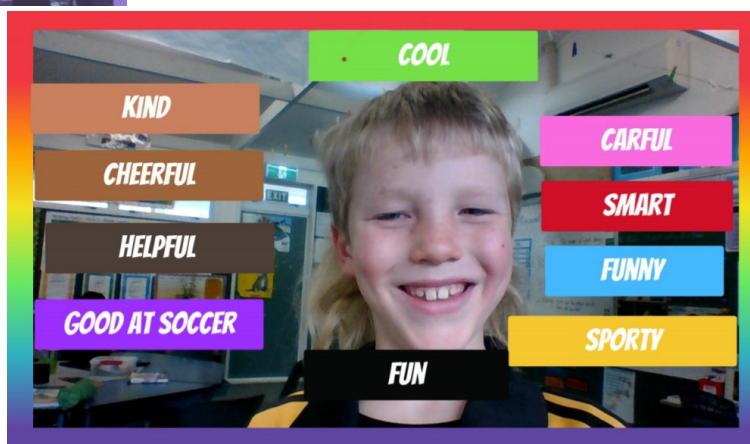
Cricket Wanganui will be running 3 different competitions for our junior players.
