About

First Fridays at the Cedarburg Cultural Center will highlight the Center's commitment to the community by showcasing the best local bands in a family friendly facility. Join us for a jam-packed evening of live music, local artist's booths and spectacular food featuring some of the area's best culinary talent creating an unforgettable entertainment experience. First Fridays is a perfect way to kick-start your weekend with dinner from an array of food vendors and kid friendly crafts activities from 6-7 pm. Check out a variety of artisans, gallery exhibits and enjoy lively music (6-9 pm) that will make you dance the night away.

Application & Fee

The booth fee is \$20 and is due at the time application is submitted. Checks and Credit Cards are both accepted.

Eligibility

First Fridays is open to all artisans 18 and over who exhibit work of original concept, design and execution and consistent with photos submitted for jurying. We pride ourselves on securing exhibitors who provide unique handcrafted and collectible items. **No kits, unfinished wood cut-outs, manufactured items or imports allowed.** All items exhibited at First Fridays **must be handcrafted.** No food or drink may be sold by exhibitors. All entries will be reviewed by a jury committee to determine appropriateness and artistic merit.

Installation & Display

Artists are responsible for providing their own display materials, which must be free standing. Spaces measure approximately 10' x 10'. Displays must fit into the space without infringing on neighboring spaces. Only one artist per space is allowed. Displays must be completely set up no later than 5:30pm on Friday. Electricity is available in most booths. If electricity is necessary, please return application early to ensure availability. All vehicles must be moved immediately after unloading, free parking is available behind the Center. Set up begins at 3:30 pm on Friday. A limited number of spaces are available.



Sales

Artists retain all proceeds from sales and are responsible for collecting and reporting sales tax.

Refund Policy

Booth fees are not refundable after acceptance has been sent.
