



# Visit an eclectic mix of distinctive Cedarburg properties...

## A. BURGER Home W65 N704 St. John St, Cedarburg

Built in 1897, this colorful Victorian has been creatively renovated and restored, inside and out. Beyond a custom stained glass door, an array of collected furniture and decorative touches highlight the home.



# B.DUCKERT Home N69 W6507 Bridge Rd, Cedarburg

This stately home built in 1907 features original stucco and decorative trim. Arts and Crafts elements and restored woodwork abound. A flowing floor plan and outdoor living space provide for gracious family living and entertaining.



# C.FRONTIER Home W66 N512 Madison Ave, Cedarburg

Dating back to the 1920s, this clever Arts and Crafts Bungalow has been carefully renovated and expanded, enhancing its characteristic style. Jenny Frontier of Bohemia, home décor boutique, has lovingly curated the works of local artists and decorative details in the home.



# D. KRAUSE Farm

800 Western Ave, Cedarburg

Situated on a working horse farm, this early 1900's farmhouse has evolved through the years and features details that reflect its pastoral setting. Included in the Tour is a peek into the outbuildings that narrate the story of the property's earliest residents: an 1860's Irish barn and the summer kitchen, home to Fleurs floral studio.





# E. DURANTE Home 251 Green Bay Rd, Cedarburg

Sited along Cedar Creek, an 1840's mill building is flanked by the mid-century modern home of Targ Durante, Cedarburg Auction and Estate Sales. This picturesque property also features the foundation of a second mill and contemporary tree house.
