

1. Death- Death is the separation of two elements which when joined together are life.


Physical death	body/soul

Spiritual death Isaiah 59:1,2	man/God Symptoms of spiritual death:

Ezekiel 18:4

man/God Symptoms of spiritual death: hatred, wars, injustice, selfishness, etc.

# III. Christ: Prophet, Priest and King

A. **Prophet-** The role of the prophet was to reveal God to His people. John 1:18

B. **Priest-** The role of the priest was to represent the people to God by: sacrificing for the people (Hebrews 7:27), interceding for the people (Hebrews 7:25) and helping the people (Hebrews 2:18).

C. **King-** The role of the king was to rule and thereby represent the authority of God. Philippians 2:9-11

  - A. Hear- Romans 10:17-receiving a message
  - B. Believe- deals with the intellect
    - 1. We must have adequate reason to believe Luke 1:4 Acts 17:23
    - Belief alone cannot save James 2:19 Luke 8:26-28

#### C. Trust

- 1. Trust implies repentance Acts 3:19 Acts 26:20 Colossians 3:5-8 Psalm 51:4 Il Corinthians 5:15
- Trust implies total dependence upon, thereby excluding works Romans 11:6 Ephesians 2:8,9
- Trust implies total commitment Mark 10:21,22 John 7:17

- D. The validity of your faith is not in how much you believe or even in the fact that you believe. The validity is in the object of your faith.
  - 1. The **basis** for your salvation is **not** that you believe in Christ or even that you prayed to ask Christ to take control of your life.
  - 2. The **basis** for salvation is in the finished work of Christ in His life, death and resurrection. Salvation is by grace plus nothing. Faith is the **means** not the basis.
  - 3. Professing Christ with the lips is important (Romans 10:9,10) However it is not the basis for salvation.
