## The LEAF's 2017 late Fall 4 Week CSA Extension

Due to this year's warm fall, The LEAF is still picking a lot of really great vegetables and will be offering a 4 week CSA program starting on Saturday November 4<sup>th</sup>,11<sup>th</sup>,18<sup>th</sup> & Dec 2<sup>nd</sup>.

- CSA pick up will be on the 4 Saturday's from November 4<sup>th</sup> through December 2<sup>nd</sup>.
- The time of Share box pick up will be 12:00pm through 2:00pm on Saturday
- Saturday's Share Box pick up is at The Leaf, 65 Blueberry Lane, Southington Ct
- There will be only one share box size being offered for the 4 week CSA program. The size
  of the share being offered is a Share Season Extender Bonus Box, This box is equal to 50
  points from or 18 week CSA program (1/2 share from the 18 week CSA program equaled
  38 points).
- The 4 week CSA Extension will be a traditional CSA, we will have your produce in a box and ready for you at the time of pick up.
- The week of November 18<sup>th</sup> (The Saturday before Thanksgiving) your CSA box will have a value of 75 points and will consist of commonly used vegetables for Thanksgiving. We will let you know when you pick up your share box on week 2 as to what will be in your box for week 3. This way you will know what to expect to have to cook with for your Thanks giving dinner.
- The Price of the Late Fall 4 Week CSA Extension is \$100.00

- We will be limiting the number of shares being sold, so sign up now to insure you get to participate in The LEAF's CSA extension.
- Some of the produce we will have available for the 4 week CSA extension are, Winter Squash, Sugar Pumpkins, Popcorn, Tomatoes, Lettuce, Spaghetti Squash, Sweet Potatoes, Beets, Brussel Sprouts, Eggplant, Peppers, Onions, Radishes, Kale, Swiss Chard, Mustard Greens, Kohlrabi, Fennel, Turnips, Carrots, Apples and Pears
- I understand that my full payment entitles me to a weekly share of the produce of which I have indicated on this form. I understand that Lewis Educational Agriculture Farm will do its best to supply as much produce as possible and may have to bring in produce from other local farms to help supply product to fulfill my share. I understand that there are risks involved in agriculture such as weather and crop failure. I understand as a member of this CSA that I share in the risk and accept unforeseen outcomes. I understand if I or another person picking up for me is unable to pick up my CSA share it will be forfeited and donated to Southington Social Services or Bread for Life. I understand that failure to pick up my share during the set pick up time without prior

notification will result in loss of my share for the week and it will be donated. I understand that my payment is nonrefundable, but
is transferable to another person by giving Lewis Educational Agriculture Farm 1 week written notification prior to transfer.
