3. The second tower was built in 1859.

4. A group of Confederate troops damaged the iron stairs.

5. Congress sets the pay for a Keeper at \$600 per year.

6. The daymark was adopted in 1873.



7. Congress appropriated \$45,000 to build the second Cape Lookout Lighthouse.

8. The new Confederate government ordered the lens removed.

9. The Union installed a third-order Fresnel lens in 1863.

10. The first-order Fresnel lens was reinstalled in 1867.
