1. The date over the doorway is when construction began on the third Bodie Island Lighthouse – 1871.



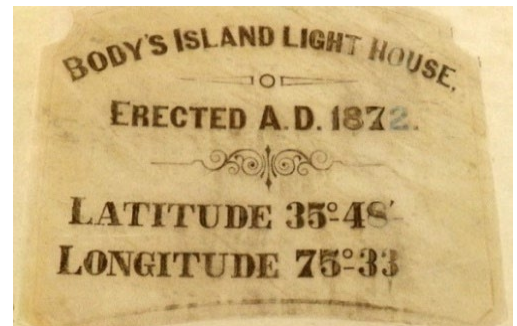
2. There are two black bands on the Bodie Island Lighthouse.



3. The building is the Lighthouse Keepers' Quarters.



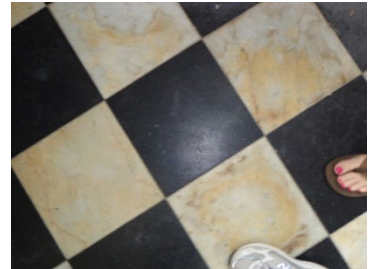
4. It was erected in 1872.



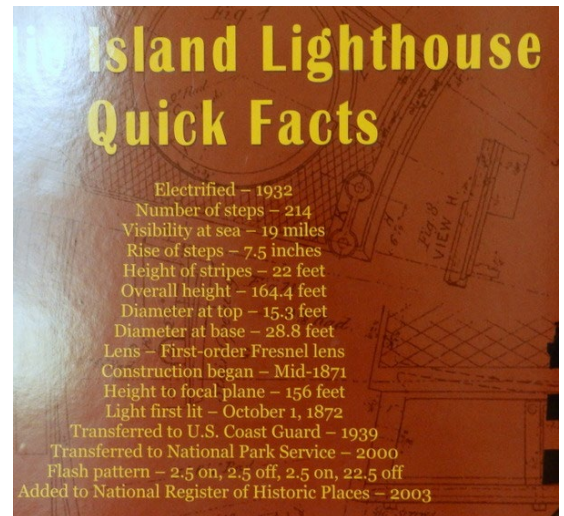
5. The stairs are black.



6. The floor at the base of the stairs is black and white.
