On the 28 February the Lord spoke to Greta that the current coronavirus crisis will come to an end suddenly. But it will require fervent prayer. Other prophetic voices concur and we discovered yesterday that Cindy Jacobs had released a worldwide call to prayer. Greta writes:

While David and I have been praying for some weeks, in the last week of February the Lord has spoken more specifically about the coronavirus outbreak and how we should respond:

1. Be sensible and careful, take wise precautions, but stay in faith and do not allow fear to overtake you.

I felt the Lord say, "The devil is whipping up fear and panic, but the Holy Spirit is stirring faith in God's people." When whipping cream, droplets spatter uncontrollably in all directions. However, stirring implies controlled movement that smoothly mixes and brings uniform consistency throughout. God wants all his people to be full of faith in him.

2. Stand on God's promises in Psalm 91, trusting in him.

The Holy Spirit has repeatedly highlighted this psalm. Some extracts (verses 3,5,6,9):

Surely he will save you from the deadly pestilence...

<u>You will not fear</u> the terror of night, nor the arrow that flies by day, nor <u>the pestilence</u> that stalks in the darkness, nor <u>the plaque</u> that destroys at midday.

If you say, "The Lord is my refuge," and you make the Most High your dwelling, no harm will overtake you, no disaster will come near your tent.

3. Pray!

The Lord is issuing a call to his Church to intercede for New Zealand and the all nations of the world.

"Again, truly I tell you that if two of you on earth agree about anything they ask for, it will be done for them by my Father in heaven." (Matthew 18:19)

Remember as you pray, that *God so loved the world...* (John 3:16). *Jesus died for the sins of the whole world...* (1 John 2:2)

Specifics to pray:

a) Pray Daniel's prayer in Daniel 9:3-19 and fast too if possible.

Like Daniel <u>cry out for God's mercy</u> as you stand in the gap (intercede) for New Zealand and all the nations of the world. The Holy Spirit has especially highlighted verses 18 & 19:

Give ear, our God, and hear; We do not make requests of you because we are righteous, but <u>because of your great mercy</u>. Lord, listen! Lord, forgive! Lord, hear and act! <u>For your sake</u>, my God, do not delay.....

For Your Great Name's Sake! Hear Us...Forgive Us...Heal Us, Lord, because of your great mercy!

b) Pray Matthew 18:18

"Truly I tell you, whatever you bind on earth will be bound in heaven, and whatever you loose on earth will be loosed in heaven.

c) Pray for an outpouring of the Spirit.

Quote from a news report: "The coronavirus outbreak has swept across the globe." Pray that a Holy Spirit outpouring sweeps across the globe.

Pray that God in his love and mercy would <u>pour out his Spirit</u>, and quell the coronavirus <u>worldwide</u>.

d) Pray for sudden cessation of the virus by miraculous divine intervention.

While it is good to pray for an accelerated breakthrough in the production of a vaccine, I have sensed Jesus say that he will douse the coronavirus outbreak by pouring out his Spirit like a mighty sprinkler system around the world to douse the fire of this plague.

He urges us to pray this into being. I feel strongly that the next **6 weeks**_are critical. We the Church need to consistently <u>pray and declare</u> that the outbreak will <u>suddenly cease</u>. Phineas <u>stood in the gap and the plague stopped</u>. (Psalm 106:30) If we will intercede on behalf of the nations, Jesus will stop it.

e) Pray for many to be saved.

The Lord will turn around this awful disease that was meant for harm and work it for good. I sensed Jesus say, "Many will turn to me and be saved as a result."

f) Pray that the world would be in awe of the miracle, and praise God for his mercy and goodness.

"I will once again astound you with amazing wonders." (Isaiah 29:14). Let many give the Lord the praise and honour for the sudden and imminent cessation of this coronavirus outbreak.
